**Subject: Joint Investment Proposal between Bangladesh and Italy for the establishment of a school in Bangladesh to provide advanced training for essential cutting-edge digital linking machine operators in the sweater garment industry and employment in Bangladesh and Italy - ITALBANGLA DIGITAL KNITTING OPERATOR TRAINING PROGRAM – aiming 1000 Job in Five year.**

Dear Mr. Saleh Ahmed Mozaffor,

As salamualaikum. As you know, our proposal for the **"Memorandum of Understanding for the Pre-Departure Training Program on Professional Training, Linguistic Skills, Safety, Customs, and Technical Internships for Trainees, Skilled, and Highly Skilled Workers from Bangladesh to Italy"** was submitted to your office on October 15, 2024, and is still actively under consideration for signing the M.O.U.

We would like to inform you that on February 26, 2024, the Italian government approved a project to start a training program in Bangladesh under the initiative of the **"Bangla Dream"**. The project was initiated in collaboration with the Italian Employment Private Organization Work Agency, the Italian Technical Training Institute Format, and the University of SIENA in Italy, with Patronization of Italian Embassy in Bangladesh and approval from the Italian Ministry of Labour Social Politics. Under this project, 100 workers from Bangladesh were approved to gain Italian language and technical training for employment in Italy. So far, 64% of the training program has been completed, and 27% of the workforce has received Italian work visas and joined and Joining with the intended of employment in Italy.

Currently, due to a lack of digital technology in Bangladesh, workers who have gone to Italy under this project need to undergo further training for at least two to three months after arriving to learn the job. This is extremely costly for Italian employers. To address this issue, the project initiative is taking steps to establish an **Advanced Digital Training Center in Bangladesh** on behalf of the projects partners a further project has been proposed to import 10 State-of-the-art Digital Linking Machines and Provide necessary training to Bangladeshi workers with the aim of sending them to Italy.

Under this project, at least 200 workers will be able to receive technical training and find employment in Italy each year. To implement this project, it will be necessary to import modern digital computerized linking machines from Italy. The total investment for the import of 10 machines at 10,000 Euros each will amount to a total of 100,000 Euros, which is approximately 13.5 million Bangladeshi Taka.

In addition, a training center needs to be established in Bangladesh, which will require 5,000 square feet for classrooms and a management office, along with hostel accommodation for at least 20 residents. For this purpose, the estimated monthly expenses for rent, teachers, principal, and management staff will be around 5,000 Euros, totaling approximately 60,000 Euros per year or 7.5 million Bangladeshi Taka.

For Training 200 Worker may need further Food and Transport indemnity may cost 300 Euro each for 3 month tanning per person totaling approximately 60,000 Euros per year or 7.5 million Bangladeshi Taka.


Total Cost BD TAKA.  $13.5 + 7.5 + 7.5 = 28.5$  Milion Taka / 200 = **142.500 Taka per person aprox.**

Euro  $100.000 + 60.000 + 60.000 = 220.000$  Euro / 200 person = **Euro 1.100 per person aprox.**

If the necessary trainers are prepared and this training center is operational, 200 workers will be able to find employment in Italy each year. We will be grateful if you provide an allocation of necessary classroom and hostel rooms for the implementation of this project at the Technical Training Center located in Gazipur, Kapasia under BMET.

Additionally, we propose your partnership in this “ ITALBANGLA DIGITAL KNITTING OPERATOR TRAINING PROGRAM”
